ARTICLE V POWERS, PRIVILEGES, AND DUTIES

Section 1. The duties and responsibilities of the officers and members of the Council AdCom shall be defined in the Bylaws, and as further delineated by the Council.

Section 2. The President shall appoint for a term concurrent with his/her presidency, a Secretary and Treasurer to the AdCom, along with the Chairpersons of the standing committees of the Council, as specified in the Bylaws. The President shall appoint the Editors of the various Council publications to terms as specified in the Bylaws. The appointments of the Editors shall be made with the advice of the Vice President for Publications. The appointment of the Treasurer shall be made with the advice of the Vice President for Finance. All appointments shall be made with the advice of the Nominations and Appointments Committee and consent of the Council AdCom. The Secretary, Treasurer, Editors and Chairpersons appointments need not be made from among the individuals who are on the Council AdCom as Society representatives.
